ePrescribe Service Fees & Authorization

NewCrop's ePrescribe service is integrated directly within the MacPractice software. It can be accessed outside of your office through use of a VPN or on an iPad using the MacPractice iEHR app. Staff can be given the privilege to enter medications for Provider or Mid-Level Prescribers to approve as needed. ePrescribe is available in two versions: Basic or Comprehensive; details listed below. EPCS services for prescribing controlled substances can be added to either Basic or Comprehensive ePrescribe.

ENROLLMENT, SETUP AND TRAINING FEES

\$250 training and setup, includes enrollment for the first provider

\$100 enrollment and setup per each additional provider enrolled

Basic ePrescribe: DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR MEANINGFUL USE

Display of allergies and medications, Indexed drug and allergy list via the First Data Bank, Unlimited Electronic Faxing, and Unlimited Electronic prescription delivery via SureScripts Messenger™ Service.

Basic eRx Usage Fee:

- **\$28 per month per provider**

Comprehensive ePrescribe: QUALIFIES FOR MEANINGFUL USE

The Comprehensive option includes all features included in the basic package as well as the additional features: Automated Drug-drug, drug-allergy and drug-diagnosis Interaction Checking, Insurance Formulary Checking, Patient Prescription History (if available via the RXHub), Printable Monographs and Leaflets. Patient leaflets are available in 18 languages.

Comprehensive eRx Usage Fee:

- **\$54 per month, per provider**

TRAINING: In order to ensure proper setup and use of the software, at least one individual who will be creating and transmitting prescriptions MUST be present for the training. One training per enrollment is included; additional training sessions can be purchased at an hourly rate if needed. Training averages around 60 minutes for Basic ePrescribe and 75 minutes for Comprehensive ePrescribe.

Electronic Prescribing of Controlled Substances (EPCS)

ADD ON SERVICE *Optional*

The EPCS feature will allow registered providers to transmit schedule 2-5 drugs electronically from MacPractice via NewCrop. This add on service is available with either Basic or Comprehensive ePrescribe. Availability varies by state and pharmacy per www.surescripts.com

Each doctor that would like to send Controlled Substances electronically will need to go through a setup process with MacPractice to enable this feature, which takes an average of 45 minutes per provider. This process includes creating an account with Exostar, which independently authenticates the prescribing provider each time they send a scheduled drug electronically. This verification process simply generates a one-time use passcode via tablet app or key fob for each prescription and requires this code before electronic transmittal.

Each prescriber that would like to send EPCS will need to enter personal information into the Exostar account in order to register. Due to the sensitive nature of the data supplied, it may be best to schedule the setup with only the prescribing physician. However, to finalize the setup, it is necessary for another MacPractice ePrescribe user to login to MacPractice and authenticate the provider to grant EPCS privileges.

EPCS Pricing:

\$150 for enrollment, set-up, and training per provider

\$150 per year, per provider (*paid to NewCrop via PayPal™)

*The Exostar fee is \$150.00 annually per EPCS provider, paid via PayPal™. However, a PayPal™ account is not required for enrolling in EPCS as you will be able to register/pay as a guest. If you do have and wish to use your PayPal™ account, please have your account credentials ready before your training date. Once EPCS has been activated for the prescribing provider, it is very important to safeguard your MacPractice login password as this now holds the key for prescribing controlled substances.

NOTE: Mid-level prescribers are not allowed to transmit EPCS in some states but may leave pending prescriptions for a doctor to review and transmit. Prescribers are required to have a DEA number to register for EPCS.
